

Buy All Sell All Rider
for Interconnection of Renewable Generation (10 kW or less)

I. Availability:

Available on a first come, first-served basis to Customers who are in the electric service area of the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville (PWC) which have an approved Renewable Generation Source of energy which is installed on the Customer's side of the delivery point, for the Customer's own use, interconnected with and operated in parallel with the PWC distribution system. The aggregate capacity of all Customer-owned generation shall not exceed 3.0% of PWC's system peak load for the prior fiscal year.

II. Definitions

Renewable Generation Source is defined as a resource of energy that comes from renewable resources such as the sun, wind and organic matter.

System Peak Load is the highest monthly hourly integrated demand for the PWC system for the prior fiscal year.

III. General Provisions:

A) An Agreement for the Interconnection of Renewable Generation Equipment 10 kW or Less must be completed before service can be received under this rider.

B) To qualify for service under this Rider, a non-residential Customer must be served on rate Schedule GS and a residential customer must be served on rate Schedule RL. The nameplate rating of the Customer's renewable generation system must not exceed the estimated maximum monthly kilowatt (kW) demand of the Interconnection service address or 10 kW, whichever is less.

C) The Customer must be a single enterprise, located entirely on a single, contiguous premise. Service hereunder shall be restricted to the energy of the Customer's generating facilities which may be operated in parallel with the PWC distribution system. Service that is necessary to supply the Customer's total load requirements shall be billed on the applicable Rate Schedule for which the Customer is receiving service. Energy delivered to the PWC under this Rider shall not offset or be substituted for power contracted for or which may be contracted for under any other schedule of PWC, except at the option of PWC under special terms and conditions expressed in writing in the contract with the Customer.

D) All other provisions of the applicable rate schedule including, but not limited to, Definition of Month, Wholesale Power Cost Adjustments, Fuel Adjustments, Payments, and Special Facilities Charges apply. Bills are due when rendered and are payable within 15 days. If a bill is not so paid, PWC has the right to suspend service in accordance with the PWC Service and Rate Regulations. All PWC Service and Rate Regulations, PWC Schedule of Deposit, Fees, and Charges, and Rate Schedules are subject to change with Commission approval.

E) PWC will furnish, install, own, and maintain all metering to measure the energy produced by the Renewable Generation Source. Customer's service shall be metered with two electric meters, one of

which measures all energy provided by PWC used by the Customer and billed under the applicable Rate Schedule, and another meter which measures the amount of energy generated by the Customer's Renewable Generation Source. PWC shall have the right to install special metering and load research devices on the Customer's Renewable Generation Source and the right to use the Customer's telephone line for communication with PWC and the Customer's Renewable Generation Source, if needed.

G) In the event PWC determines that it is necessary to install a dedicated transformer or other equipment to protect the safety and adequacy of electric service provided to other customers, the Customer shall pay an Extra Facilities Charge as specified in PWC's Service and Rate Regulations for the additional equipment.

H) Should the Customer decide to participate in the North Carolina Green Power Program, the Customer should contact them directly for specific information. If for any reason the Customer does not use the renewable energy credits (REC's) or "green tags" associated with Renewable Generation Source Energy, PWC may claim credits for PWC's use.

IV. Rate

Monthly Basic Facility Charge per meter:

4 terminal single phase:	\$ 9.00
5 terminal three phase	\$ 15.00

Credit for the Energy produced by the Renewable Generation Source shall be based on the kilowatt hours delivered to PWC for the bill month. The Credit shall apply to the standard month's bill and charges. Credit shall not offset the Basic Facility Charge.

For all bills rendered on or after:	
June 1, 2009 – July 31, 2010	\$0.02087
August 1, 2010 – July 31, 2011	\$0.02119
August 1, 2011 - June 30, 2012	\$0.02150

V. Minimum Bill

The monthly minimum bill for Customers serviced under this Rider shall be no less than the Monthly Basic Facilities charges from the applicable Rate Schedule and the Extra Facilities Charge, if applicable.
