

LARGE INDUSTRIAL SERVICE TIME-OF-USE

(optional)

AVAILABILITY - Available, at the customer's option, throughout the territory served by the Public Works Commission in accordance with the Commission's established service regulations.

APPLICABILITY - To electric service used for industrial purposes where the maximum demand exceeds 10,000 kW.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE - Service shall be three-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at the Commission's standard available voltages. Service shall be provided at a single point of delivery through one meter.

MONTHLY RATE -

Basic Facilities Charge	\$500.00
On-Peak Demand Charge	
For up to 5,000 kW	\$17.90 per kW
For the next 5,000 kW	\$16.75 per kW
For all additional kW	\$15.60 per kW
Excess Off-Peak Demand Charge	\$ 2.00 per kW
Energy Charge	
For all On-Peak kWh	\$0.032 per kWh
For all Off-Peak kWh	\$0.030 per kWh

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND - The monthly demand charges shall be the sum of the On-Peak Demand Charge and the Excess Off-Peak Demand Charge computed as follows:

1. The On-Peak Billing Demand shall be the higher of:
 - a. The 15-minute interval kW recorded or computed during the On-Peak period; or,
 - b. 50% of the contracted demand until such time as the recorded or computed demand, either On-Peak or Off-Peak, first equals or exceeds the contracted demand.
2. The Excess Off-Peak Billing Demand, where applicable, shall be the maximum 15-minute interval kW recorded or computed during the Off-Peak period less the On-Peak billing demand.

(CONTINUED)

DETERMINATION OF ON-PEAK AND OFF-PEAK PERIODS -

1. On-Peak hours shall be defined as daily (not including Saturdays, Sundays or holidays) periods as follows:

Summer (April-October) 1:00 PM to 10:00 PM

Winter (November-March) 6:00 AM to 12:00 Noon & 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM

2. Off-Peak hours shall be defined as all other hours.

PRIMARY DISCOUNT - A primary discount will be given where the customer takes service directly from the Commission's distribution lines of 7,200 volts or higher, but less than 69,000 volts, and the customer owns, operates, and maintains the equipment normally provided by the Commission. The primary discount will be given in the form of reduced On-Peak Demand Charges as follows:

Primary Discount	\$0.50 per kW

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT - This rate schedule is predicated upon a power factor of 85% or higher at the time of maximum On-Peak kW. In situations where the required power factor is not maintained, the registered or computed On-Peak kW demand will be increased by one percent for each one percent by which the power factor is less than 85%.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT - All stated energy rates are subject to adjustment according to Schedule PCA.

PAYMENTS - Bills are due when rendered and are payable within 20 days. If a bill is not so paid, PWC has the right to suspend service in accordance with the service regulations.
