PWC is seeking an individual to perform lead work in the construction and repair of underground/overhead lines for electrical transmissions/distributions systems. Responsibilities include troubleshooting power outages, and/or service abnormalities; providing technical expertise in correcting problems; installing/repairing poles, conductor, or cable transformer related equipment; requisitioning material; preparing/completing logs and reports. Candidate must have thorough knowledge of electrical systems/utility operations; hazards and safety precautions involved in power line work; good knowledge of PWC service areas; skill in using communication systems; be able to read and interpret maps; and communicate effectively both orally and in writing. Candidate must be available to work extended hours and emergency calls when necessary.
