Responsibilities will include performing moderately specialized engineering work involving surveys, investigations, plans and structures with moderate to complex features; designing/reviewing moderate to complex drawings, plans and specifications of proposed projects; using judgment and expertise for recommendations/modifications/troubleshooting problems; performing moderate to complex engineering studies; compiling and analyzing data; performing field work; and meeting with customers and contractors concerning proposed utility services. Individual must have thorough knowledge of principles/practices of engineering; thorough knowledge of supervisory concepts and practices; and skill in using applicable computer software. Successful candidate must be able to perform accurate complex mathematical computations; design and interpret complex engineering maps, drawings and blueprints; evaluate and solve technical engineering problems; coordinate, plan and prioritize work; prepare and maintain reports/records; effectively supervise employees as well as managing multiple projects. **Water and wastewater experience preferred.**

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from a four (4) year accredited university/college with a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering and a minimum of two (2) years of progressively responsible experience, performing civil engineering work for a public or private utility, which includes reviewing/monitoring the work of others.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1 Must pass the Professional Engineering (PE) examination within two (2) years of eligibility for candidacy for the P.E. examination.

2 Must be able to obtain and maintain a valid North Carolina Driver's License when selected for this position.
