**Note:** FPWC is currently paying \$131.12 per ton; this year's bid price is \$119.20 per ton which represents a decrease of \$71,520.00 over the term of the contract. The low bid is recommended.

2. Oltrin Solutions, LLC, Hamlet, NC, low bidder in the amount of \$403,000.00 for the purchase of approximately 3,250 tons of 15% Sodium Hypochlorite. Bids were solicited from thirty-four (34) bidders with two (2) bidders responding.

**Note:** FPWC is currently paying \$131.40 per ton; this year's bid price is \$124.00 per ton which represents a decrease of \$24,050.00 over the term of the contract. The low bid is recommended.

3. Univar USA Inc., Morrisville, PA, low bidder in the amount of \$470,718.00 for the purchase of approximately 2,300 tons of 50% Caustic Soda. Bids were solicited from (34) bidders with (3) bidders responding.
