



**SMALL POWER SERVICE**

(This rate schedule applies to Rate SE-NRes)

**AVAILABILITY** Available throughout the territory served by the Public Works Commission in accordance with the Commission's established service regulations.

**APPLICABILITY** To electric service used for nonresidential uses where the demand is less than or equal to 30 kW, if demand exceeds 35 kW at least twice in a calendar 12 month period or if demand exceeds 50 kW once in a calendar 12 month period, Customer may be moved to Medium Power Service. Demand, for purposes of determining the applicability of this rate schedule, shall be computed on the basis of the aggregate demand measured by the billing meter installed by PWC at the point of delivery for the Customer and the non-billing meter installed by PWC on the Customer's side of the point of delivery to measure the output of all customer-owned generation, including but not limited to peak shaving generation and generation from qualifying facilities, but excluding generation used solely for emergencies in compliance with the operational limitations and emissions limitations established by the applicable North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality air permit.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE** Service shall be single phase or three-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at the Commission's standard available voltages. Service shall be provided at a single point of delivery through one meter.

**DEFINITION OF PEAK PERIODS**

Peak period is defined as daily (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays)

**(CONTINUED)**

**WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (WPCA)** All stated energy rates are subject to a monthly wholesale power cost adjustment (WPCA).

**COAL ASH RIDER** As specified in the service regulations, a monthly surcharge to recover Duke Energy Progress Cost in cleaning up Coal Ash allocated to PWC.

**Coal Ash Rider** **\$8.82**

**PAYMENTS** All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.

**SPECIAL FACILITIES CHARGES** As specified in the service regulations, a monthly surcharge may be assessed for special facilities provided by PWC.

**Contract Private Lighting** **\$4.00**  
**Contract Street Lighting** **\$4.00**

**TAX** Applicable North Carolina Sales Tax will apply.

\*An additional \$4.00 Community Street Lighting charge applies to each meter on this rate schedule.

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
