



RESIDENTIAL SERVICE Additional Meter

(This rate schedule applies to Rate Code E-RESAM)

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by the Public Works Commission in accordance with the Commission's established service regulations.

APPLICABILITY To electric service for any additional meters on domestic premises in and about residential dwelling units as limited by the service regulations. The primary residential meter on the premise and this meter must be in same name, with no non-residential usage. Energy usage on this rate is limited to a maximum of 200 kWh. If usage for any three months in a calendar twelve month period, goes over 200 kWh, then the meter will be moved to an applicable Non-Residential Rate.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE Service shall be single-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at the Commission's standard available voltage except as provided for in the service regulations.

MONTHLY RATE

Basic Facilities Charge*

Single Phase Service Charge	\$20.00
Three Phase Service Charge	\$25.00

Energy Charge

All kWh On Peak times:	\$0.13000 per kWh
All kWh Off Peak times:	\$0.08473 per kWh

DEFINITION OF PEAK PERIODS

Peak period is defined as daily (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays)

1. On Peak Hours:

Summer:	(April-October)	3:00 PM to 7:00 PM
Non-Summer:	(November-March)	6:00 AM to 10:00 AM

2. Off Peak Hours: All other hours

3. Holidays are deemed Off-Peak

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (WPCA) All stated rates are subject to a monthly wholesale power cost (WPCA).

COAL ASH RIDER As specified in the service regulations, a monthly surcharge to recover Duke Energy Progress Cost in cleaning up Coal Ash allocated to PWC.

Coal Ash Rider **\$2.00**

SPECIAL FACILITIES CHARGES As specified in the service regulations, a monthly surcharge may be assessed for special facilities provided by PWC.

Contract Private Lighting **\$4.00**
Contract Street Lighting **\$4.00**

PAYMENTS All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.

TAX Applicable North Carolina Sales Tax will apply.

*An additional \$4.00 Community Street Lighting charge applies to each meter billed on this rate schedule.
