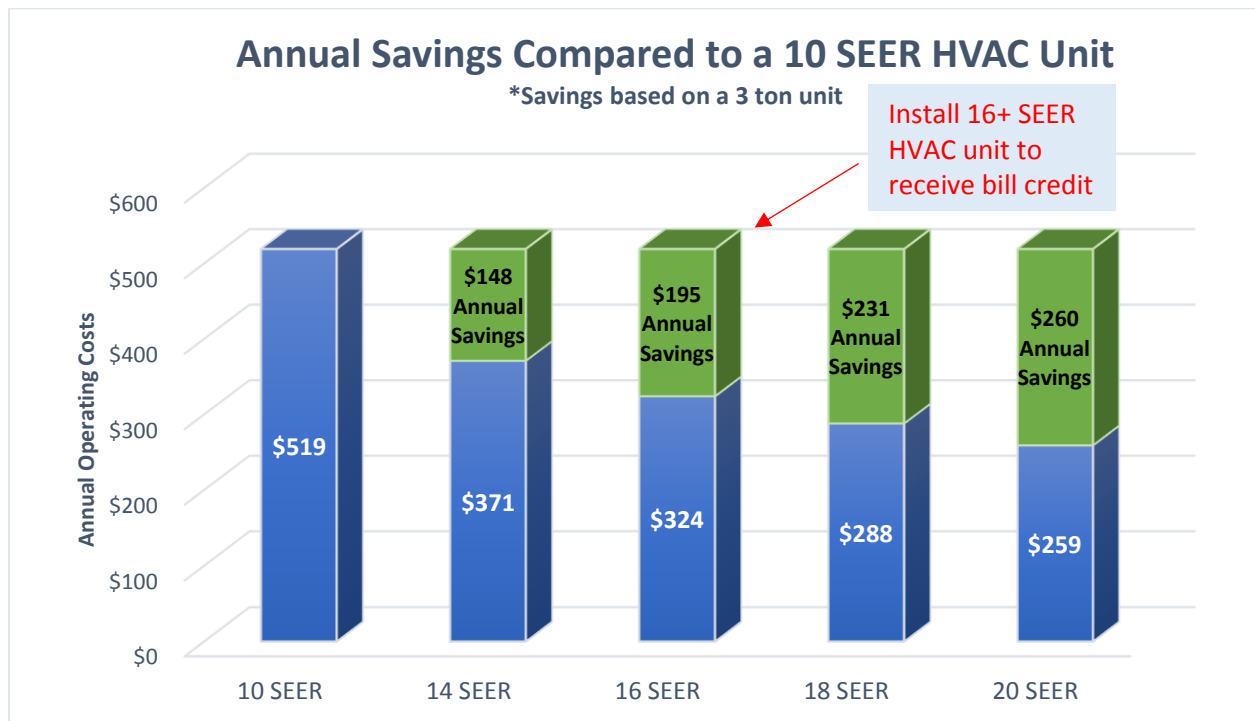


ENERGY STAR HVAC INCENTIVE PROGRAM

This chart illustrates how much you can save when you install a new HVAC system that offers greater efficiency and comfort. Annual operating costs are based on a 3-ton heat pump at an average cost of \$.098 per kilowatt hour. SEER stands for Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio. The higher the number, the less electricity needed for operation. Operating costs are dependent on usage patterns, home characteristics, and climate conditions. Setting the new system's thermostat to minimize usage during peak billing periods can help reduce your electric bill even further.
