



RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICE - INSIDE CITY

(This schedule applies to Rate W-RES; SW-RES)

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by the Public Works Commission, inside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with the Commission established Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY Applies to water supplied for residential purposes at a single point of delivery through a single meter.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with the Commission's approved flow standards.

MONTHLY RATE The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge plus the Backflow Prevention Assembly Inspection Charge, where applicable.

BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY INSPECTION CHARGE In situations where a split tap is done on the customer’s side of the meter for the purpose of lawn and garden watering, swimming pool filling, etc., an additional monthly charge of \$2.20 shall be assessed for periodic inspection of the backflow prevention assembly device.

CONTRACT PERIOD The contract period shall be continuous from the date of connection through the date of disconnection.

WATER SHORTAGE ORDINANCE Should the PWC’s General Manager declare/proclaim a water shortage, this rate is subject to change by adding a 15% surcharge to usage over 5,000 gallons.

UTILITY LINE RELOCATION RIDER As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge to recover utility line relocation due to expansions that are allocated to PWC.

Utility Line Relocation Rider - for Residential \$2.00

PAYMENTS All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.
