



**RESIDENTIAL SANITARY SEWER SERVICE-OUTSIDE CITY**

(This schedule applies to Rate Code SWW-RES;WW-RES)

**AVAILABILITY** Available throughout the territory served by the Public Works Commission, outside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with the Commission's established service regulations.

**APPLICABILITY** Applies to residential sanitary sewer service where the customer is billed monthly for PWC metered water service and where all wastewater is discharged into the sanitary sewer system at a single discharge point.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE** Wastewater shall be collected and treated in accordance with the Sanitary Sewer Use Ordinance of the City of Fayetteville.

**MONTHLY RATE** The monthly rate shall be the sum of the Usage Charge, the Basic Facilities Charge, and the Sanitary Sewer Surcharge (where applicable).
