RESOLUTION APPROVING A WATER SUPPLY PLAN FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE

WHEREAS, G.S. 143-355 (1) requires that each unit of local government that provides public water services or plan to provide such services shall, either individually or together with other such units of local government, prepare and submit a local water supply plan; and

WHEREAS, as required by the statute and in the interests of sound local planning, a water supply plan for the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville has been developed and submitted for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville recognizes it is currently in the process of compiling and updating its projections of future water needs and preparing a 2000 update to its local water supply plan as required for participants in the third round of the Jordan Lake water supply storage allocation process; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Commission finds that the water supply plan is in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 143-355 (1) and that it will provide appropriate guidance for the future development of water supplies for the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville, as well as useful information to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for the development of a state water supply plan as required by statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville that the water supply plan entitled Water Supply Plan dated October 30, 1998 is hereby approved and shall be submitted to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville intends that this plan shall be revised to reflect changes in relevant data and projections at least once every five years or as otherwise requested by the Department, in accordance with the statute and sound planning practice.
