

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE WILL OBSERVE OCTOBER 7-13, 2007 AS
PUBLIC POWER WEEK**

WHEREAS, the Fayetteville Public Works Commission provides reliable electricity to its more than 74,000 customers; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Fayetteville are consumers and owners of their public power system and exercise local control over utility operations and policies;

WHEREAS, the dedicated employees of PWC are neighbors serving neighbors and exemplify the qualities of Public Power by providing fast response 24 hours a day, 365 days a year; and

WHEREAS, the Fayetteville Public Works Commission is one of only 11 municipal electric utilities who has received the American Public Power Association's Diamond Level Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3) award indicating the highest level of electric reliability; and


WHEREAS, our electric system is a community asset that contributes to the well-being of the citizens by providing safe and reliable power, excellent local customer service and economic development opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Fayetteville is the largest public power city of more than 70 in North Carolina, and the 37th largest out of more than 2,000 public power systems in the United States; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Fayetteville Public Works Commission does hereby declare that it's Officers, Agents and Staff will observe October 7 through October 13, 2007, as "Public Power Week" in an effort to promote public power and those who work in our cities and towns to provide the best possible electric service for our citizens.
