

**RESOLUTION OF THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA  
APPROVING WATER SHORTAGE RESPONSE PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute 143-355 (l) requires that each unit of local government that provides public water services or plans to provide such services shall, either individually or together with other such units of local government, prepare and submit a Water Shortage Response Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, as required by the statute and in the interests of sound local planning, a Water Shortage Response Plan for the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville has been developed and submitted to the Public Works Commission (COMMISSION) for approval; and


**WHEREAS**, the COMMISSION finds that the Water Shortage Response Plan is in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 143-355 (l) and that it will provide appropriate guidance for the future management of water supplies for Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville, as well as useful information to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for the development of a state water supply plan as required by statute;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION** that the Water Shortage Response Plan entitled, Water Shortage Response Ordinance dated May 24, 2010 is hereby approved and shall be submitted to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Water Resources; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the COMMISSION intends that this plan shall be revised to reflect changes in relevant data and projections at least once every five years or as otherwise requested by the Department, in accordance with the statute and sound planning practice.
