RESOLUTION APPROVING SOURCE WATER RESILIENCY AND RESPONSE PLAN

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 130A - 320 requires that each unit of local government that provides public water service from a surface water source shall create and implement a Source Water Resiliency and Response Plan; and

WHEREAS, as required by the statute and in the interests of sound local planning, a Source Water Resiliency and Response Plan for Fayetteville Public Works Commission has been developed and implemented and certification of such will be submitted to the State of North Carolina, Department of Environmental Quality upon approval of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the Fayetteville Public Works Commission, that the Source Water Resiliency and Response Plan dated August 2020 is hereby approved, and certification shall be submitted to the State of North Carolina, Department of Environmental Quality.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fayetteville Public Works Commission intends that this plan shall be revised to reflect changes in relevant data and projections at least once every five years or as otherwise requested by the Department, in accordance with the statute and sound planning practice.
