 - i. The manhole to be replaced is in extremely poor condition due to the amount of H2S that is produced by Cargill. The current manhole is a former wet well. We are replacing it with a Polymer Concrete Manhole (Armorock or US Composite Pipe). C-900 will be used to tie everything back in.
 - b. Contract Duration 45 calendar days from NTP
 - c. Bonds required
 - i. Performance Bond 100% of Price
 - ii. Payment Bond 100% of Price
 - d. Warranty One (1) year from final acceptance
- 3. Construction Issues
 - a. Customer Service
 - i. Keep Cargill Happy
 - b. Working Times
 - i. 7am-5pm (Depending on Cargill)
 - c. Erosion Control
