

CAPITAL PROJECT ORDINANCE AMENDMENT
 2014 ELECTRIC CONNECT REVENUE BOND CAPITAL PROJECT FUND AMENDMENT #2
 PWCORD2016-05

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission (FPWC) that pursuant to Sections 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following capital project fund is hereby amended:

Section 1. The amendment authorized is to the 2014 Electric Connect Revenue Bond Capital Project Fund, adopted May 28, 2014 and June 9, 2014 by FPWC and the City of Fayetteville (CITY), respectively, as amended, for the implementation of advanced electric metering infrastructure for all electric meters to be financed by revenue bonds.

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby directed to continue with completion of the project within the budget

Section 3. The following amounts are appropriated for the project:

Section 5: The FPWC Chief Financial Officer will maintain sufficient accounting records and will ensure the terms of the bond resolution are met.

Section 6: Funds may be advanced from the FPWC General Fund for the purpose of making payments as due and reimbursement requests will be made to the Trustee in an orderly and timely manner.

Section 7. Copies of the capital project fund ordinance amendment shall be made available to the FPWC general manager and finance officer.
