

SMALL POWER SERVICE-WHOLE BUSINESS

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC") in accordance with PWC's established Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY Applicable to electric service used for non-residential uses where the demand is less than or equal to 30 kW; provided, however, if demand exceeds 35 kW at least twice in any twelve (12) consecutive month period or if demand exceeds 50 kW at least once in any twelve (12) consecutive month period, PWC may move Customer to Medium Power Service. Demand, for purposes of determining the applicability of this rate schedule, shall be computed on the basis of the aggregate demand measured by the billing meter installed by PWC at the point of delivery for the Customer and the non-billing meter installed by PWC on the Customer's side of the point of delivery to measure the output of all customer-owned generation, including but not limited to peak shaving generation and generation from qualifying facilities, but excluding generation used solely for emergencies in compliance with the operational limitations and emissions limitations established by the applicable North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality air permit.

<u>CHARACTER OF SERVICE</u> Service shall be single-phase or three-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at PWC's standard available voltages except as provided for in the Service Regulations and Charges. Service shall be provided at a single point of delivery through one meter.

DEFINITION OF PEAK PERIODS

Peak period is defined as daily (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays)

1. On-Peak Hours:

Summer: (April-October) 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM Non-Summer: (November-March) 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM 2. Super Off-Peak Hours: (January-December) 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM

- 3. Off-Peak Hours: All hours other than On-Peak Hours and Super Off-Peak Hours.
- 4. All holiday and weekend hours are deemed to be Off-Peak Hours.

POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTMENT (PSA) All stated rates are subject to a monthly power supply adjustment (PSA).

<u>COAL ASH RIDER</u> As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge to recover the portion of Duke Energy Progress' cost of cleaning up coal ash that is allocated to PWC.

PAYMENTS All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.

SPECIAL FACILITIES CHARGES As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge may be assessed for special facilities provided by PWC.
