- 1. Regarding budgets (Scope Item 2-8th Bullet), does PWC anticipate budgets will require engineering seal or certification? No
- 2. Will the selected grant consultant and/or firm that grant consultant is employed by be eligible to pursue design development and other services that could emerge should PWC move forward with the project (with or without state and or federal funding)? If so, does PWC anticipate providing all pre-funding information and funding award information as part of the RFQ for design services of that project? Each grant writing project will be separate from any implementation project and will not limit participation from any consultant in other PWC efforts. Services will be focused on competitive grant programs, so implementation funding is not guaranteed.
- 3. Does PWC intend to use the selected consultant for all state and federal grant and loan programs moving forward, and if so, what is the time frame before this service expires? If not, how does PWC intend to handle these same services on unique and/or specific projects? Services will be based on available grant opportunities that PWC seeks to pursue as separate projects.
- 4. Has PWC identified specific capital improvement projects that they plan to seek state and or federal funding for? If so, will PWC provide a listing of those projects? Initial research/planning has taken place, but specific projects will not be matched to grant programs until official language is released from federal/state agencies.
