

NON-RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICE – OUTSIDE CITY

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by Fayetteville Public Works Commission (“PWC”), outside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with PWC’s Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY Applies to water supplied for non-residential or industrial purposes where the maximum demand does not exceed 1,000 Mgals, three (3) or more times in any twelve (12) month consecutive billing period, at a single point of delivery through a single meter.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with PWC’s approved flow standards.

MONTHLY RATE The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge.

CONTRACT PERIOD The contract period shall be continuous from the date of connection through the date of disconnection.

WATER SHORTAGE ORDINANCE Should PWC’s General Manager declare/proclaim a water shortage, this rate is subject to change by adding a second block (all usage over 5 MGAL) and the usage charge will be 15% higher than the prevailing usage charge.
