

LARGE WATER USER

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC"), in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY Applicable, at the option of the customer, to water supplied where monthly water consumption exceeds 1,000,000 gallons at least three (3) times during a rolling twelve (12) month consecutive billing period, at a single point of delivery through a single meter.

<u>CHARACTER OF SERVICE</u> The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with PWC's approved flow standards.

MONTHLY RATE The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge.
