

RESIDENTIAL GRINDER PUMP GRANT PROGRAM

The Residential Grinder Pump Program is a reimbursement program for single family residential property owners, who are required to install a grinder pump in order to discharge waste water (sewer) from a residential property located in the Phase V sewer extension areas into the PWC's sanitary sewer system.

APPLICATION The following conditions must be satisfied in order for a residential property owner to be eligible to qualify for reimbursement under this program:

- 1. Gravity sewer must not be reasonably available to the residential property located in the Phase V sewer extension areas.
- 2. The residential property must require the installation of a grinder pump in order to discharge waste water (sewer) into PWC's sanitary sewer system.
- 3. The assessment on the residential property must not have been discounted or reduced in any manner.

GRANT AWARD PWC will award a one-time grant reimbursement up to \$4,200 to reimburse a residential property owner for the actual incurred cost of a grinder pump that is required to be installed in order the residential property in the Phase V sewer extension areas to be connected to PWC's sewer system. In order to receive the reimbursement grant, the residential property owner must furnish to PWC a completed plumbing inspection certificate and a paid invoice from the plumbing contractor identified on the plumbing permit as part of the grant request.
