RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DESIGN-BUILD CRITERIA

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes ("NCGS") § 143-128 authorizes Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC") to use the design-build method pursuant to NCGS § 143-128.1A for any contract to erect, construct, alter, or repair buildings;

WHEREAS, the Commission supports use of the design-build method for a project when appropriate and where the method will provide the best value to PWC; and

WHEREAS, NCGS § 143-128.1A requires PWC to establish in writing the criteria used for determining the circumstances under which the design-build method is appropriate for a project.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE FAYETTEVILLE PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION THAT:

- 1. The following shall be used for determining the circumstances under which the design-build method is appropriate for a project:
 - a) The extent to which PWC can adequately and thoroughly define the project requirements prior to the issuance of the request for qualifications for a design-builder.
 - b) Any time constraints for delivery of the project.
 - c) The ability to ensure that a quality project can be delivered.
 - d) The capability of PWC to manage and oversee the project, including the availability of experienced staff or outside consultants who are experienced with the design-build method.
 - e) The ability to show good-faith efforts to comply with NCGS §§ 143-128.2 and 143-128.4, and to recruit and select small business entities.
 - f) A comparison of the costs and benefits of using the design-build delivery method for a given project in lieu of the other delivery methods identified in NCGS § 143-128(a1)(1), (2), and (4).
- 2. PWC staff who want to use the design-build method must provide to the CEO a memo applying the criteria set forth above to the proposed project to support use of the method for the specified project.
- 3. The CEO or the CEO's designee(s) are hereby authorized to determine whether the design-build method is appropriate for a project. The CEO is further authorized to enter into design-build contracts that require the estimated expenditure of funds in an amount less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000). Any design-build contract undertaken by PWC that requires the estimated expenditure of funds equal to or greater than five hundred thousand dollars

(\$500,000) shall be approved by the Commission and a majority vote of the City of Fayetteville City Council.
