2. Following are questions received about the solicitation and the SME's answers to the questions.

- Q1. Has it been determined if any utility poles will need to be relocated for this project? Or light poles?
- **A1.** This requirement would be identified in a separate RFQ or IFB issued on behalf of the electric division. Please monitor the PWC website for any forthcoming opportunities.
- **Q2.** The RFQ States that the due date is 10/26, but the Pre-Bid Meeting Agenda states that the due date is 10/27. Which date is correct?
- **A2.** The correct due date is October 26, 2023, by 2:00 pm
- **Q3.** The RFQ asks that the information be "tabbed as identified" are divider pages that include the section titles sufficient?
- **A3.** Yes, the divider pages that include the section titles are sufficient.
- **Q4.** If a consultant has exceptions to the General Contract Terms and conditions (Service Agreement), should those be listed in the statement of qualifications?
- A4. Yes
- **Q5.** Does the Certificate of Insurance count towards page limits? Do we need to submit COI for subconsultants in section 1 as well?
- **A5.** No, the Certificate of Insurance does not count towards page limits. A COI is not needed for sub-consultants. If they are a joint venture, then the answer is yes, a COI will need to be provided.
