Dear Vendor:

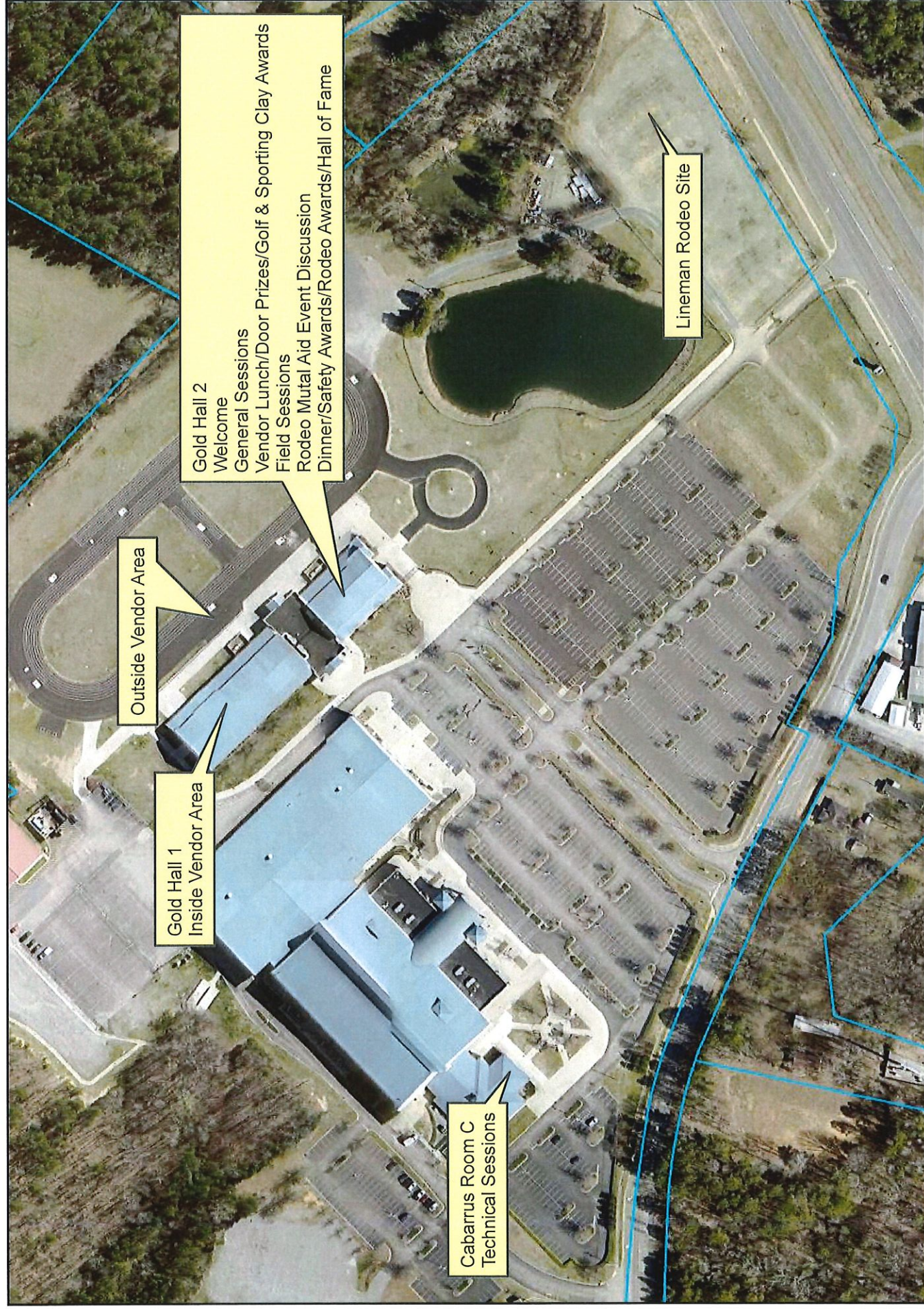

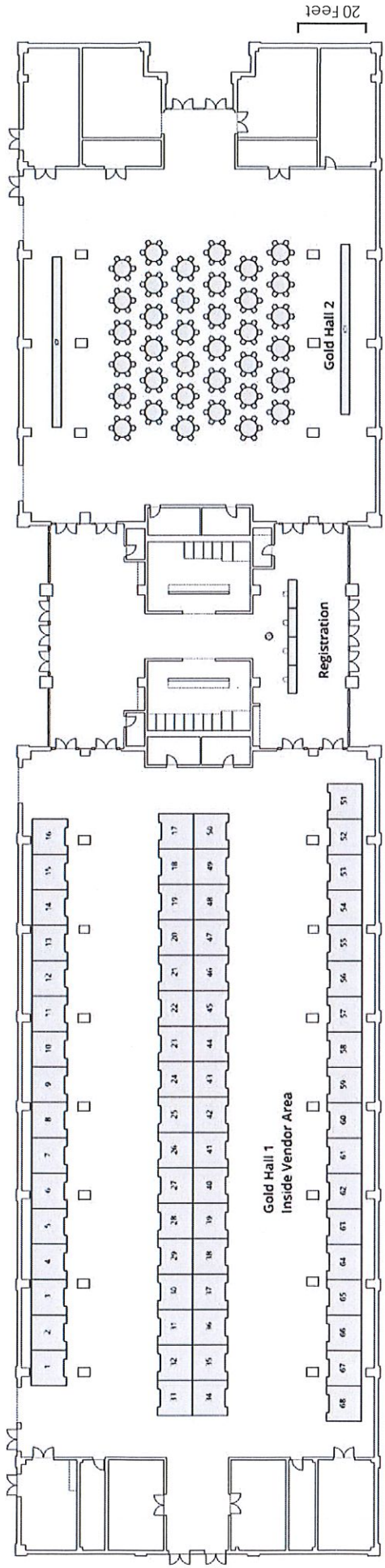

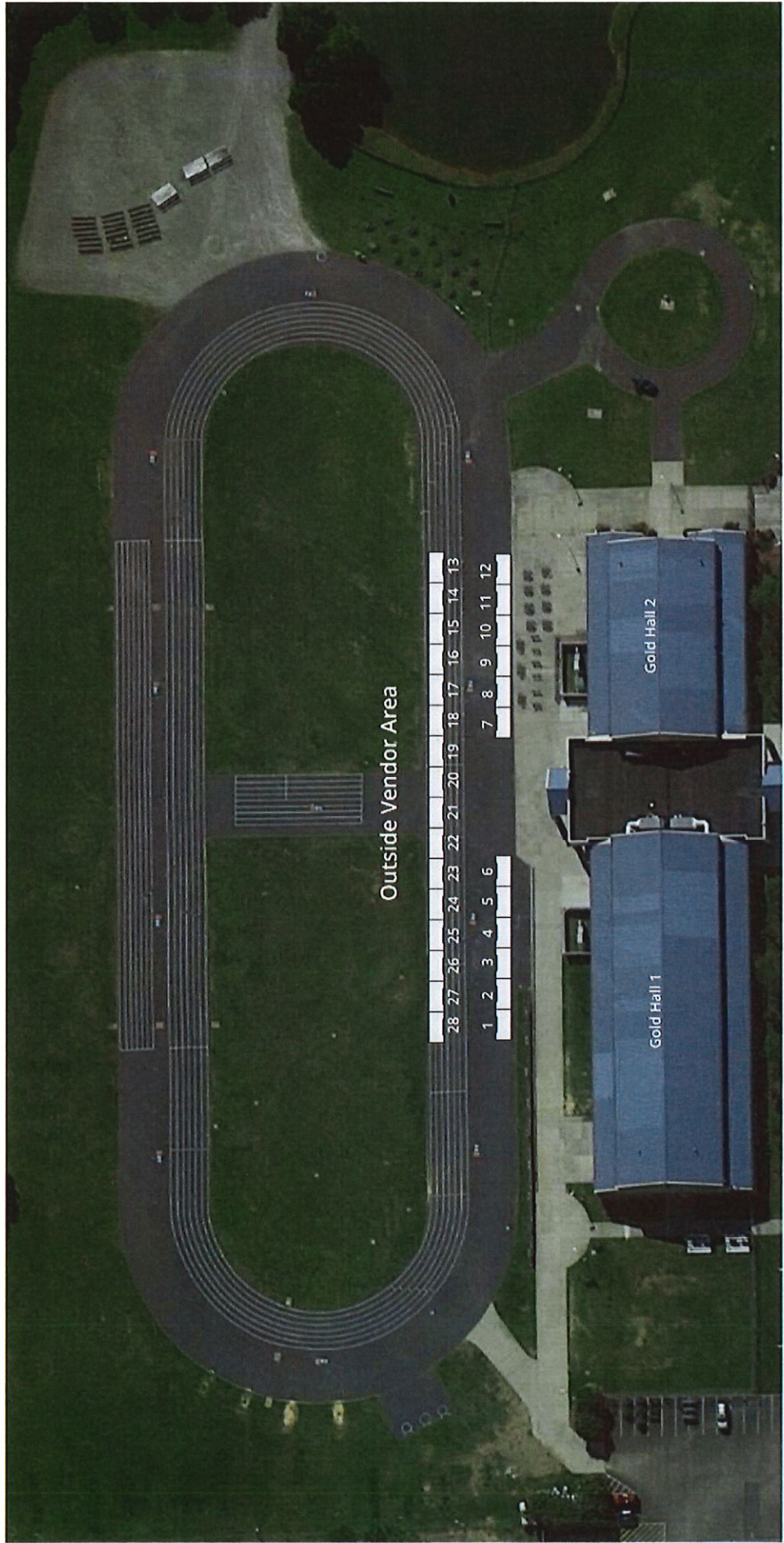
