

## **RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICE – OUTSIDE CITY**

**AVAILABILITY** Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC"), inside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

**APPLICABILITY** Applies to water supplied for residential purposes at a single point of delivery through a single meter.

<u>CHARACTER OF SERVICE</u> The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with PWC's approved flow standards.

**MONTHLY RATE** The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge plus the Backflow Prevention Assembly Inspection Charge, where applicable.

**BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY INSPECTION CHARGE** In situations where a split tap is done on the customer's side of the meter for the purpose of lawn and garden watering, swimming pool filling, etc., an additional monthly charge of \$3.65 shall be assessed for periodic inspection of the backflow prevention assembly device.

**CONTRACT PERIOD** The contract period shall be continuous from the date of connection through the date of disconnection.

**WATER SHORTAGE ORDINANCE** Should PWC's General Manager declare/proclaim a water shortage, this rate is subject to change by adding a 15% surcharge to usage over 5,000 gallons.

<u>UTILITY LINE RELOCATION RIDER</u> As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge to recover utility line relocation due to expansions that are allocated to PWC.

Utility Line Relocation Rider - for Residential \$4.00

**PAYMENTS** All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.
