



**LED LIGHTING SERVICE**

**AVAILABILITY** Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission (“PWC”) in accordance with PWC’s Service Regulations and Charges.

**APPLICABILITY** Applicable to dusk-to-dawn electric service used for illuminating private outdoor areas using LED lights (Light-emitting diode). Service under this schedule is not available for illuminating indoor areas or public thoroughfares.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE** Service shall generally consist of a luminaire owned, installed, powered, and maintained by PWC.

**MONTHLY RATE**

**A \$4.50/month charge can be added to the luminaire charge for additional facilities needed for Light.**

**FACILITIES CHARGES** Provisions for additional facilities as needed or as requested shall be assessed prior to installation. Additional facilities which may include trenching, conductors, transformers, etc. may be considered as one-time charges or included in the monthly rate, as delineated in the Service Regulations and Charges.

**POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTMENT (PSA)** All stated rates are subject to a monthly power supply adjustment (PSA).

**CONTRACT PERIOD** As detailed in the service regulations, the contract period for LED lighting service shall be three (3) years.

**PAYMENTS** All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.

**TAX** Applicable North Carolina sales tax will apply.
