

LED LIGHTING SERVICE

AVAILABILITY Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC") in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

<u>APPLICABILITY</u> Applicable to dusk-to-dawn electric service used for illuminating private outdoor areas using LED lights (Light-emitting diode). Service under this schedule is not available for illuminating indoor areas or public thoroughfares.

<u>CHARACTER OF SERVICE</u> Service shall generally consist of a luminaire owned, installed, powered, and maintained by PWC.

MONTHLY RATE

A \$4.50/month charge can be added to the luminaire charge for additional facilities needed for Light.

Additional facilities which may include trenching, conductors, transformers, etc. may be considered as one-time charges or included in the monthly rate, as delineated in the Service Regulations and Charges.

POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTMENT (PSA) All stated rates are subject to a monthly power supply adjustment (PSA).
