AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the territory served by Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC"), outside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY

Applies to water supplied for non-residential or industrial purposes where the maximum demand does not exceed 1,000 Mgals, three (3) or more times in any twelve (12) month consecutive billing period, at a single point of delivery through a single meter.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with PWC's approved flow standards.

MONTHLY RATE

The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge.
