AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC") in accordance with PWC's established Service Regulations and Charges.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to electric service used for domestic purposes in and about residential dwelling units as limited by the Service Regulations and Charges.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Service shall be single-phase or three-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at PWC's standard available voltage except as provided for in the Service Regulations and Charges.

MONTHLY RATE

DEFINITION OF PEAK PERIODS

Peak period is defined as daily.

I. On-Peak Hours

b. Non-Summer (November – March):	6:00 AM to 9:00 AM
Super Off-Peak Hours (January – December):	9:00 PM to 5:00 AM

III. Off-Peak Hours: All hours other than On-Peak Hours and Super Off-Peak Hours

POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTMENT (PSA)

All stated rates are subject to a monthly power supply adjustment (PSA).

SPECIAL FACILITIES CHARGES

As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge may be assessed for special facilities provided by PWC.
