#### AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the territory served by Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC"), outside the limits of the City of Fayetteville, in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

# APPLICABILITY

Applies to water supplied for irrigation purposes at a single point of delivery through a single meter for a residential customer.

#### CHARACTER OF SERVICE

The volume of water flow and residual pressure at the point of delivery shall be in accordance with PWC's approved flow standards.

#### MONTHLY RATE

The monthly rate shall be the Usage Charge plus the Basic Facilities Charge, plus the Backflow Prevention Assembly Inspection Charge for residential customers.

### BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEBILY INSPECTION CHARGE

In situations where a single-family residential customer has a split water lateral for the purpose of lawn and garden watering, swimming pool filling, etc., an additional monthly charge of \$3.90 shall be assessed for periodic inspection of the backflow prevention assembly device.

### **CONTRACT PERIOD**

The contract period shall be continuous from the date of connection through the date of disconnection.
