## AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission ("PWC"), in accordance with PWC's Service Regulations and Charges.

# **APPLICABILITY**

- I. Applies to residential or non-residential sanitary sewer service where the customer receives all water requirements from sources other than from the water mains of the Public Works Commission, where all wastewater is discharged into the sanitary sewer system at a single discharge point and no water meter billing usages are received from the other water company to bill the customer;
- II. To residential or non-residential customers who have de minimis storm water runoff running into PWC's sanitary sewer service and the cost to remove the storm water discharge is impractical or the expense is excessive. In these instances, a determination will be made on a case by case basis by the Water Resources Division;
- III. To residential or non-residential customers who have dumpster pads where the drains run into PWC's sanitary sewer service.

### CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Wastewater shall be collected and treated in accordance with the Sanitary Sewer Use Ordinance of the City of Fayetteville.

I. Flat Monthly Rate

a. Inside City Limits \$53.22b. Outside City Limits \$93.14

# **CONTRACT PERIOD**

The contract period shall be continuous from the date of connection through the date of disconnection.

# UTILITY LINE RELOCATION RIDER

As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge to recover utility line relocation due to expansions that are allocated to PWC.
