

**Fayetteville Public Works Commission  
Electric Rate Schedule RLAS  
Residential Service Additional Meter**

**R.B.20**

**AVAILABILITY**

Available throughout the territory served by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission (“PWC”) in accordance with PWC’s established Service Regulations and Charges.

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to electric service for any additional meters on domestic premises in and about residential dwelling units as limited by the Service Regulations and Charges. The primary residential meter on the premise and this meter must be in same name, with no non-residential usage. Energy usage on this rate is limited to a maximum of 200 kWh. If usage for any three (3) months in any twelve (12) consecutive month period goes over 200 kWh, then the meter will be moved to an applicable Non-Residential Rate.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE**

Service shall be single-phase or three-phase, sixty hertz alternating current at PWC’s standard available voltage except as provided for in the Service Regulations and Charges.

**MONTHLY RATE**

I.	Basic Facilities Charge*	
	a. Single-Phase Service Charge:	\$28.00
	b. Three-Phase Service Charge:	\$35.00
II.	Energy Charge	
	a. All kWh On-Peak Hours:	\$0.15915 per kWh
	b. All kWh Off-Peak Hours:	\$0.10375 per kWh

**DEFINITION OF PEAK PERIODS**

Peak period is defined as daily.

I.	On-Peak Hours	
	a. Summer (April – October):	3:00 PM to 6:00 PM
	b. Non-Summer (November – March):	6:00 AM to 9:00 AM
II.	Off-Peak Hours: All hours other than On-Peak Hours	

**POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTMENT (PSA)**

All stated rates are subject to a monthly power supply adjustment (PSA).

**SPECIAL FACILITIES CHARGES**

As specified in the Service Regulations and Charges, a monthly surcharge may be assessed for special facilities provided by PWC.

I.	Contract Private Lighting	\$4.00
II.	Contract Street Lighting	\$4.00

**PAYMENTS**

All bills shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the Service Regulations and Charges.

**TAX**

Applicable North Carolina sales tax will apply.
