The Fayetteville City Council has adopted the Preliminary Assessment Resolution for extending utility services to Area 30 Section I in the Phase 5 Annexation project. A Public Hearing on the Preliminary Assessment Resolution will be held at 6:30 p.m. on March 23, 2026, in Council Chambers of City Hall, located at 433 Hay Street, Fayetteville, NC 28301. PWC would like to emphasize assessments will not be billed until the utility service is installed and another Public Hearing has been held for public comment. Most properties impacted by this project are typical single-family residential lots that will be assessed \$5,000, which is an amount considerably less than the actual cost of extending the utility service. For commercial and other non-single-family properties, the assessment will be based on road frontage at \$55.56 per front foot with a 90-foot minimum plus the average lateral charge for the area which, again, is less than the actual cost of installation. Pre-payment options are available for assessments and financial assistance will also be available for those who qualify.
